M.TECH PART-TIME QIP PROGRAMME FOR ENGINEERING COLLEGE / POLYTECHNIC
TEACHERS AND WORKING PROFESIONALS

GENERAL INFORMATION / GUIDELINES:

Name of the Course: M.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering

Visvesvaraya Technological University proposes to offer M.Tech (Part-Time, QIP) programme for Engineering college / Polytechnic teachers and Working professionals from the academic year 2010-11.

This programme will be conducted in the Department of Computer Science & Engineering, **R.V.College of Engineering**, a well-established college affiliated to VTU. The college is recognized as an Extension Center of the University for the QIP Program.

The objectives of the program are:

1. To overcome the shortage of qualified faculty in Technical Institutions.
2. To improve the quality of Technical Education in the state of Karnataka.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Admission to the Part Time Master of Technology Quality Improvement Program shall be open only to the regular faculty working in institutions in Karnataka State who have passed B.E/B.Tech Examinations in relevant field of VTU or any other University/Institution or any other examinations recognized as equivalent thereof with a minimum of one year of experience.

AMIE qualification in respective branches shall be taken as equivalent to B.E/B.Tech courses of VTU for Part Time M.Tech. QIP admission. However, a candidate seeking admission to M.Tech, course with this qualification shall also take the Common Entrance Test.

Admission to Part Time M.Tech, QIP shall be open to the candidates who have passed the prescribed qualification examination with First Class as indicated in the degree certificate.

Seats shall be apportioned among the faculty of college, industry and polytechnic in the ratio 20:3:2.

The Engineering graduates other than the graduates of any of the Universities of Karnataka State shall have to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the VTU to seek admission to P.G. course in any of the colleges affiliated to VTU.

Part-time QIP students shall take admission for the course under this program shall have their place of working within 100 kms from the institution where they seek admission

Course duration: Three years

Syllabus:

As per the regular M.Tech in Computer Science & Engineering, but the subjects of first year are spread to two years in the part-time course.

Application form: is available by paying a DD of Rs. 100/- in favour of Principal, RVCE, Bangalore or cash of Rs. 100/-.

Last date for the submission of application: 29-5-2010.

Filled in applications with relevant certificates – (Degree certificate, Experience certificate, No-objection certificate from the organization or sponsorship certificate from the institution) should reach Head of the department, Department of Computer science and engineering on or before 30-5-2010.

Entrance test will be held on 12-6-2010 and the result will be announced on 15-6-2010.

Intimation to eligible candidates will be by email by 6-6-2010.

Students should register by paying full fees before 23-6-2010.

Fee Structure:

1. Engineering college / Polytechnic teachers:
Rs.42,035/- (Tuition fee- 30,000 + University fee-5035 + College fee- 7500/-)per year.
2. Working professionals from industries:
Rs.52,035/-(Tuition fee- 40,000 + University fee-5035 + College fee- 7500) per year.

Examination:

1. On-line examination system will be followed for the programme.
2. Exams will be conducted in nodal centers.
