Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the Junior Research Fellow (JRF) position for the research project titled "An IoT device for Remote Monitoring and Classification of bat species" funded by Bat Conservation India Trust (BCIT), Bangalore.

Essential qualifications:

Candidates with a Postgraduate degree in CSE/ECE discipline. A substantial computer programming background in any scientific language is essential, and prior knowledge of IoT and Machine Learning is preferred.
