RV College of Engineering: Engg freshers to be briefed on reforms at induction

Engg freshers to be briefed on reforms at induction

Bengaluru: After bringing in major reforms in the first and second semester engineering curriculum for the upcoming academic year, engineering colleges are set to brief students about them during the 21-day induction programme from Monday.

All engineering colleges are expected to conduct the programme for 21 days, as per the All India Council of Technical Education. It is usually split into 11 days for first semester and 10 days for second semester.

This year, colleges have decided to set apart a day to explain to students how the new scheme will work and how they should be selecting courses based on their passion and course requirement.

The programme is expected to include areas like physical activity, creative arts, universal human values, literary, proficiency modules, lectures by eminent people, visits to local areas and campus tour.

“These students are teenagers coming from schools. The focus is to ensure even non-Karnataka students settle in comfortably,” said V Venkatlakshmi, dean, first year, AMC Engineering College. **RVCE will have sessions from industry leaders on motivation. BMSCE sessions will include discipline and career opportunities in armed forces.**
